UNIPU has experience in implementing Erasmus+ program, action K1. In period from 2010 and 2021 total value of **Erasmus+** grants was 1,441,218.09 EUR.

UNIPU was granted for two project within Horizon Europe program. Career Acknowledgement for Research (Managers) Delivering for the European Area - CARDEA, 101058572 project aims at developing the Research Managers (RM) who strengthen Europe's R&I excellence through a diverse set of support roles and responsibilities. Research Management as a profession is almost invisible from policy, career progression and tenure opportunities across Europe.
